Hi Peggy,

From what Joe Trammell reported in the Utility Committee meeting, I don't have a solid sense of what actually caused the two 11 pH water quality events or the low pressure water event, or that these problems could not occur again.

I think it is reasonable and prudent to ask Joe to put in writing, to the Council, and publish to the Borough, the cause of these events and the steps taken to prevent further events. Please ask Joe to include any information about the delivery, and addition to our system, of any sodium hydroxide the day before the first ph event, including the name of the company, and individual making the delivery and the steps taken to add the sodium hydroxide to our system, and by whom. Please ask Joe to provide the modal number of the pumps involved and also the manufacturer's recommended maintenance schedule for these pumps. Please ask Joe to also state if those maintenance recommendations had been followed by our W/S operator, and provide any written documentation available.

The given explanation that the overage of sodium hydroxide in our water treatment plant system was caused by a "syphon" effect, and cured by raising the level of the supply pump off of the floor, does not sound complete. Perhaps the "syphon" explanation also does not apply to our second pH event. Please ask Joe to comment, if he has input from Carmella or any other "expert" as to these facts.

Please ask Joe to comment as to whether he has arranged oversight of our W/S plant operator by any competent W/S engineer or licensed operator who has legal authority to take on this responsibility. I think it is not fair to ask Joe to take on these legal responsibilities himself as, I do not believe has the necessary qualifications.

Please read this email in the "Correspondence" section of the Council meeting tonight. Sorry I cannot attend this meeting as I am out of town.
