



WHEREAS, each plant has a generator to provide such back-up power, and both generators are presently in need of repair; and
WHEREAS, Modern Group Power Systems, which currently services the generators, has submitted proposals to repair the generators; and
WHEREAS , the proposed cost of repairing the water treatment plant generator is \$3,899.50, and of repairing the sewer treatment plant generator is \$3,285.22; and
WHEREAS, the governing body finds that in consideration of the season, the public health, safety and welfare requires that the repairs be completed as soon as practical; and
WHEREAS , pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.3 to 5.5 as amended effective June 5, 2017, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds in the amount of \$7, 184.72 are available for this contract; now, therefore, be it
