- 4) The Council reserves the right to pass over duplicative written comments; however, each duplicative comment shall be noted for the record with the content summarized.
- A member of the public wishing to speak during a remote meeting shall state their name and address for the record prior to making their comment.
- Members of the public commenting during a remote meeting shall not act in any manner to disrupt the meeting. If such a member of the public becomes disruptive during the meeting, the individual chairing the meeting shall mute, or direct the muting of, the disruptive member and warn that any continued disruption may result in the member being prevented from speaking during the meeting or be removed from the remote meeting. Disruptive conduct includes, but is not limited to, sustained inappropriate behaviors such as shouting, interruption, and the use of profanity.
- Any member who continues to be disruptive after receiving a warning may be muted while other members of the public are allowed to proceed with their comments. If time permits, the disruptive individual shall be allowed to speak after all other members of the public are provided an opportunity to comment. Should the individual remain disruptive, the individual may be muted or kept on mute for the remainder of the remote meeting or removed from the meeting.

Adequate notice of this meeting, as required by Chapter 231, P.L. 1975, has been provided by a public notice on January 25, 2021 which was posted on the Bulletin Board at the Roosevelt Post Office and in the Borough Hall. WHEREAS, \$2.5 million is available for costs associated with updating community centers, playgrounds, fields, walking or bicycle trails, multi-sport courts, and recreational facilities, professional service costs, and equipment costs including playground and recreational facilities equipment; and
WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer recommends the Borough make an application for improvements to the Roosevelt Amphitheater which includes the replacement of brick sidewalk, brick retaining walls, ADA improvements, electrical improvements, and cleaning and restoration of the Franklin D. Roosevelt bust; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Borough Engineer says the costs to prepare a grant scope, cost estimate, final application, and submit online may be completed in the amount not to exceed \$3,500.
