As you know, the Borough received funding through the NJDOT Municipal Aid program for the Improvements to North Valley Road contract in the amount of \$219,420.00. This funding requires that a contract be awarded no later than November 23, 2024.

This project requires right-of-entries and easements for proposed stormwater improvements within private property. It is uncertain if the right-of-entries and easements will be executed prior to the November 23, 2024 award deadline.

As such, I recommend that the Borough request a 6-month extension from the NJDOT for awarding a contract for the Improvements to North Valley Road project, as is allowable by the NJDOT Sate Aid Handbook, at the next available Council Meeting. Once a resolution is passed, please provide to this office so that we may submit to the NJDOT on behalf of the Borough.

Dear Mayor and Council:

As you know, the Borough has recently been informed that it is required by the NJDEP to prepare a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SPPP) to stay in compliance with its Stormwater Permit. Although we requested a Stay from preparation of the SPPP, the NJDEP will not release the remaining \$50,000 grant for the transfer from a Tier B to a Tier A permit until the SPPP is submitted. To prepare the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan, Roberts Engineering Group, LLC will undertake the research necessary and prepare the Plan to reflect how the Borough complied with the permit in 2023 at a cost not to exceed \$4,500.00.

The Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan should be submitted as soon as possible so that the Borough may receive the remaining \$50,000.00 from the awarded \$75,000.00 grant. Please provide authorization to move forward with the SPPP as soon as possible.

(FFR), I am writing to confirm that we have approved funding for the third phase of design services for the Borough's Amphitheater project consisting of the **FDR Amphitheater-Rendering+Additional Meetings/Presentations Add-Service** as outlined in ETM Associates, L.L.C. proposal addressed to Connie Herstrom dated August 20, 2024.

BOND ORDINANCE NO. 2024-09 INTRODUCTION DATE: 07-01-2024 PUBLIC HEARING DATE: 09-05-2024

BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE FRANKLIN DELANO ROOSEVELT AMPHITHEATER PROJECT, APPROPRIATING \$710,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$676,000 BONDS AND NOTES TO FINANCE A PORTION OF THE COSTS THEREOF, AUTHORIZED IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF ROOSEVELT, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ROOSEVELT, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The improvements described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are hereby authorized as general improvements to be undertaken in and by the Borough of Roosevelt, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Borough"). For the improvements or purposes described in Section 3, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$710,000, said sum being inclusive of all appropriations heretofore made therefor, including \$34,000 as the down payment for said purposes as required by the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-1 et seq. The down payment is now available by virtue of provision for down payment or for capital improvement purposes in the Capital Improvement Fund of one or more previously adopted budgets.
- Section 2. In order to finance the costs of said improvements or purposes not provided for by the application of the down payment, negotiable bonds are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount not to exceed \$676,000, pursuant to the Local Bond Law. In anticipation of the issuance of said bonds and to temporarily finance said improvements or purposes, negotiable bond anticipation notes are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.
- Section 3. (a) The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which the obligations are to be issued consist of the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Amphitheater Project, including, but not limited to, demolition, excavation, milling, paving, landscaping and lighting, together with all purposes necessary, incidental or appurtenant thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with plans, specifications or requisitions therefor on file with or through the Borough Chief Financial Officer, as finally approved by the governing body of the Borough.
- (b) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued for the improvements or purposes described in Section 3(a) hereof is \$676,000, as stated in Section 2 hereof.
- (c) The estimated cost of the improvements or purposes described in Section 3(a) hereof is \$710,000, which is equal to the amount of the appropriation herein made therefor. The

excess of the appropriation of \$710,000 over the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued therefor being the amount of said \$34,000 down payment for said purposes.

- Section 4. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the chief financial officer of the Borough, provided that no note shall mature later than one (1) year from its date. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-8. The notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the chief financial officer, who shall determine all matters in connection with notes issued pursuant to this ordinance, and the chief financial officer's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. The chief financial officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The chief financial officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of such notes occurs, such report shall include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.
- Section 5. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:
- (a) The improvements or purposes described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are not a current expense and are improvements or purposes that the Borough may lawfully undertake as general improvements, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.
- (b) The average period of usefulness of the improvements or purposes, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and taking into consideration the amount of the obligations authorized for said purposes, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the bonds authorized by this bond ordinance, is twenty (20) years.
- (c) The Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly prepared and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk, and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. Such Statement shows that the gross debt of the Borough as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided in this bond ordinance by \$676,000 and the obligations authorized herein will be within all debt limitations prescribed by that Law.
- (d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$20,000 for interest on said obligations, costs of issuing said obligations, engineering costs, legal fees and other items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included as part of the cost of said improvements and is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for said improvements.
- (e) To the extent that moneys of the Borough are used to finance, on an interim basis, costs of said improvements or purposes, the Borough reasonably expects such costs to be paid or reimbursed with the proceeds of obligations issued pursuant hereto. This ordinance

shall constitute a declaration of official intent for the purposes and within the meaning of Section 1.150-2(e) of the United States Treasury Regulations.

- Section 6. The capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available there for public inspection.
- Section 7. Any grant or similar moneys from time to time received by the Borough for the improvements or purposes described in Section 3 hereof, shall be applied either to direct payment of the cost of the improvements within the appropriation herein authorized or to payment of the obligations issued pursuant to this ordinance. The amount of obligations authorized but not issued hereunder shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are received and so used.
- Section 8. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. The obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Borough, and, unless paid from other sources, the Borough shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Borough for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation as to rate or amount.
- Section 9. This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Roosevelt, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 5: "Animal Control" of the Borough's Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (stricken text indicates deletions, <u>underlined text</u> indicates additions):

#### CHAPTER 5

#### ANIMAL CONTROL

\* \* \*

#### § 5-14 WILDLIFE FEEDING.

This section shall prohibit the feeding of unconfined wildlife in any public park or on any other property owned or operated by Borough of Roosevelt to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply.

#### § 5-14.1 Definitions.

For the purpose of this section, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this section clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

#### **FEED**

To give, place, expose, deposit, distribute or scatter any edible material with the intention of feeding, attracting or enticing wildlife. Feeding does not include baiting in the legal taking of fish and/or game.

#### **PERSON**

Any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this state subject to municipal jurisdiction.

#### WILDLIFE

All animals that are neither human nor domesticated.

#### § 5-14.2 Prohibited Conduct.

No person shall feed, in any public park or on any other property owned or operated by the Borough of Roosevelt, any wildlife, excluding confined wildlife (for example, wildlife confined in zoos, parks or rehabilitation centers, or unconfined wildlife at environmental education centers, or feral cats as part of an approved Trap-Neuter-Release program).

#### § 5-14.3 Enforcement.

- a. This section shall be enforced by the New Jersey State Police and/or the Borough's Animal Control Officer and/or the Borough's Code Enforcement Officer.
- b. Any person found to be in violation of this section shall be ordered to cease the feeding immediately.

#### § 5-14.4 Violations and Penalties.

Any person(s) who is found to be in violation of the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500 for a first offense; \$1,000 for a second offense; and \$2,000 for a third or subsequent offense.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance. All other provisions of the Revised General Ordinances are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, if any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect upon final passage and publication, according to law.


