#### **PROHIBITED ITEMS:**

**TV SETS!!**

**COMPUTER EQUIPMENT**

**CONSTRUCTION/DEMOLITION MATERIALS**

**TIRES**

**CAR BATTERIES**

**PAINT CANS**

**CHAIN LINK FENCE**

**CAR PARTS**

**SMALL MACHINES WITH OIL OR GASOLINE**

**Small machines (ex: lawn mowers) can be picked up if gasoline and oil are removed**

**LARGE ITEMS MUST BE BROKEN DOWN IN SIZE TO EQUAL NO MORE THAN 45 POUNDS PER LIFT**

**LAWN DEBRIS – GRASS CLIPPINGS – LEAVES – TREE BRANCHES - STICKS**

**STONE OR CONCRETE PRODUCTS**

**BATTERIES OF ANY KIND**

**HAZARDOUS WASTE MATERIALS**

**FLUORESCENT LIGHT TUBES**

**RECYCLABLE MATERIALS**

**PROPANE BOTTLES OR GAS CANS**

# **ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:**

Major appliances and large bulky metal items, including stoves, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, hot water heaters can be placed curbside for collection. Doors from refrigerators, freezers, stoves must be removed from the hinges. (Beacon Metal in Freehold, 732-462-0543, may be able to assist you with a scrapper for your appliances anytime during the year.)

**In accordance with DEP regulations, all Freon must be removed from refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers and air conditioners. Licensed refrigeration persons' stickers must be attached to these items.**

Furniture

Carpeting must be cut to 36" widths, rolled and tied into bundles not heavier than 45 pounds.

All small items must be placed in containers (other than cardboard boxes) – not heavier than 45 pounds.

**ITEMS PLACED ON CURBS WHICH ARE NOT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THESE GUIDELINES WILL NOT BE PICKED UP AND SHOULD BE REMOVED.**

**\*SEPARATE METAL FROM ALL OTHER BULK\***
