**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROOSEVELT AMENDING CHAPTER 7:
“VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” OF THE BOROUGH CODE AT SECTION 7-15 TO CREATE A
NEW YIELD INTERSECTION AT HOMESTEAD LANE AND NORTH VALLEY ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Roosevelt, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey (the “Borough”) operates and maintains certain public roadways within its municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the Borough’s attention that the intersection of the municipal roadways at Homestead Lane and North Valley Road should be made safer by creating a new yield intersection at said location;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Roosevelt, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Borough Code Chapter 7: “Vehicles and Traffic” shall be amended to supplement Section 7-15 therein as follows (~~stricken text~~ indicates deletions, underlined text indicates additions):

7-15 YIELD INTERSECTIONS.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the intersections described are hereby designated as Yield Intersections. Yield signs shall be installed as provided therein.

Intersection	Yield Sign On
<u>Southerly Connector Road</u> westbound-eastbound between North Valley Road and Homestead Lane	<u>Southerly Connector Road</u> westbound <u>eastbound</u> at North Valley Road Homestead Lane
Tamara Drive and Pine Drive	Tamara Drive
Tamara Drive Spur northbound and Pine Drive	Tamara Drive Spur northbound
Tamara Drive Spur southbound and Tamara Drive	Tamara Drive Spur southbound

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portion of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to that end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies only; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon final passage and publication.
